Young Alumni Achievers Nomination Process

RATIONALE

To quote the Emmanuel College Vision and Mission Statement, we commit ourselves:

“To empower our students to serve and act with compassion and justice as members of Church, local and global communities.”

Emmanuel College values the contributions of all of its students past and present. Since 2009 alumni have been recognised via the Inspiring Alumni award in order to inspire current and future students and alumni, and following in the spirit of this award we introduce Young Alumni Achievers. The Young Alumni Achievers aims to recognise our younger cohort of alumni at an early-mid stage of their personal and professional development as they build themselves into significant contributors to the local or global community.

PRESENTATION

Alumni Young Achievers will be recognised at Emmanuel College’s biennial event – “An Evening of Inspiration”. There will be a limit of six recipients of the award at the event across a diverse range of categories. Recipients will be acknowledged as a collective on stage at the event and a brief summary of their achievements to date. Each recipient will be awarded with a trophy.

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Anyone can make a nomination for Alumni Young Achiever recognition.

Nominations will be sought by Emmanuel College from the College and local community via:

- The alumni magazine, the College Connection in the two editions following the Evening of Inspiration
- College social media platforms
- Other College publications, such as the newsletter
- Local media

Nominations will close the last Friday in January, the year of the event.

Previously nominated alumni who were unsuccessful may be renominated. A new nomination must be completed.

PROCESS

1. Nominations for Alumni Young Achievers are to be called for biennially.
2. Nominations must be submitted on the prescribed nomination form. A receipt of the nomination will be acknowledged in writing.
3. The Alumni Recognition Group will review nominations against the specified selection criteria and make recommendations to the Executive Team for endorsement.
4. Names of the endorsed nominees will be reported to the Advisory Council at a meeting during Term 1 in the year of the Evening of Inspiration.
5. Successful candidates will be contacted by the Principal and advised of preparations for the event.

SELECTION CRITERIA

In considering nominations for the awards, selection will be based upon combinations of the following criteria. Nominees must:

1. Be graduates of, or received a substantial portion of their education at, Emmanuel College.
2. Be under the age of 35.
3. Have demonstrated excellence or received recognition in their chosen field of endeavour; or exemplified the best attributes of giving and community spirit in today's world.
4. Model strong social and Christian values, which is of inspiration to others.
